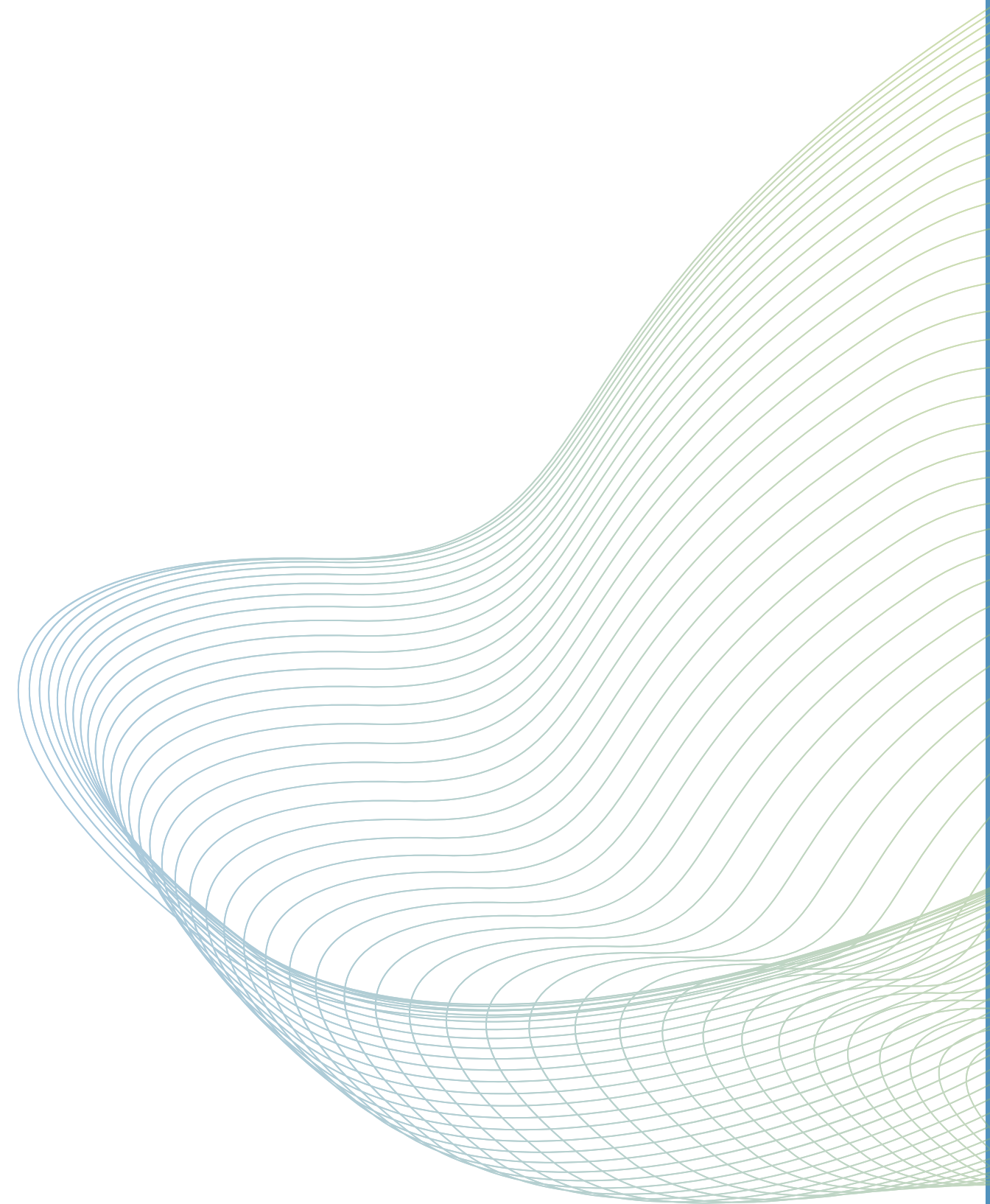

Our membership is open to all health and service providers within the auto rehab sector, including sole providers, small-medium sized clinics, and large organizations.

Your ORA membership level is based on the **number of staff working with MVA clients under your company name**. This way they may all have access to the ORA membership resources and benefits.

Membership Levels



1 FTE (sole providers)

Only 1 member access / login is provided at this level.

\$385.00 Annually



2 - 5 FTE (small companies)

Member access / logins are provided for up to 5 staff members.

\$550.00 Annually



6 - 15 FTE (medium companies)

Member access / logins are provided for up to 15 staff members.

\$935.00 Annually



16 + FTE (large companies)

Member access / logins are provided for up to 20 staff members.

\$1375.00 Annually

UNDERSTANDING MEMBERSHIP LEVELS

Membership fees are the primary source of funding for the Ontario Rehab Alliance's advocacy work, resources, and initiatives—efforts that support our entire sector by addressing the unique challenges of the motor vehicle accident (MVA) rehabilitation system.

ORA membership levels are based on the number of staff working with MVA clients under your company name, rather than your total business size. This more accurately reflects the scope of our advocacy and ensures that membership contributions are aligned with how companies participate in the MVA system.

When determining your membership level, please include any contracted health service providers (HSPs) who work under your company name. Even if these individuals are not direct employees, they are seen as part of your organization in the eyes of insurers and clients, and they benefit from the advocacy and resources the ORA provides to their membership companies.

CLARIFYING SOLE PROVIDER / SOLE PROPRIETOR

The Sole Provider / Sole Proprietor level is reserved for individuals who practice as solo practitioners—those who operate their own registered business without contractors or additional HSPs practicing under their company name.

These members function solely as themselves and may use a personal logo or brand within our directory. In our online directory, they may link to a LinkedIn profile instead of a company website, reflecting their individual practice.

This level is also reserved for individuals who are health service providers employed/contracted by a non-member clinic. We understand that there are a number of HSPs who are passionate about advocating for provider rights as well as their client's rights within the MVA rehab sector. You choose to join the ORA under the 1 FTE Level. As such your personal name will be shared on the Directory and you may choose to link to your personal LinkedIn page or personal email address.
